### **SLING SELECTION PROCESS**

## **1** CARRY OUT A RISK ASSESMENT

The manual handling of patients can pose a serious risk to healthcare workers. In fact, injury due to manual handling accounts for 42% of incidents in this environment (Safe Work Australia, 2013). It is therefore important to understand your risk and manage it, by considering the following factors when using your sling.

#### 1. Task

- Is the sling choice appropriate to the task?
- What other equipment is required for the task?
- How frequently will the task occur?

#### 2. Environment

- Is there enough space to carry out the transfer?
- Is the floor level and smooth?
- Are there any trip hazards that could cause injury to the carer or patient?
- Can other equipment in the room minimise the manual handling effort eg. changing bed height?

#### 4. Equipment

- Is the sling choice appropriate to the patient's functional ability?
- Is the sling choice compatible with the lifter?
- Is the sling fabric appropriate to the task and the patient?
- Does the carer know how to apply the sling and safely operate the lifter?
- Is the sling in good condition? It should not be used if fraying, snags or tears are evident.
- Can the labelling be read on the lifter and sling?
- Is the lifter or sling due to have a service?

#### 3. Individual

- What is the patient's functional ability?
- Can the patient assist with the transfer?
- Can the patient comply with the transfer?
- Does the patient have a medical condition which may impact the transfer?
- Are there medical devices to consider eg. catheters or drains?

#### 5. Load

- Is the sling the correct size for the patient's body shape and height?
- Does the patient have a physical presentation which may impact upon the choice of sling eg. amputation?
- Does the sling have an appropriate safe working load (SWL) for the patient's weight?







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#### **APPLY YOUR SLING** 5

A. Deluxe General Purpose Sling (From Sitting)



1. Feed sling behind user's back down to base of spine and position. Ensure all labelling and handles are visible on the outside of the sling.



2. Feed each leg strap underneath each leg, ensuring no twists or folds in the fabric.



3. Bring the straps through the yellow webbing loop to ensure user comfort and safety (optional).



1. Use recognised manual handing techniques and position the sling under the user. Ensure all labelling and handles are visible on the outside of the sling.



2. Feed each leg strap underneath each leg ensuring no twists or folds in the fabric.



4. Once sling is in place, connect the desired loops (or clips) to the yoke. If using loop attachments, ensure the colours are the same on each side.



5. Commence your lift, ensuring that all loops (or clips) remain secure on the yoke at all times. If correctly positioned, all straps should take up at the same time.



6. When removing the sling, ALWAYS peel it away from the user to avoid skin friction/shear.



4. Once sling is in place, connect the desired loops (or clips) to the yoke. If using loop attachments, ensure the colours are the same on each side.

TIPS:



5. Commence your lift, ensuring that all loops (or clips) remain secure on the yoke at all times. If correctly positioned, all straps should take up at the same time.

#### **TIPS:**

- To keep the user in a sitting position, choose short straps at the shoulders and long straps at the legs.
- Throughout the lift, maintain good communication and instruction with your patient.

- Don't forget that you can change the height and position of the bed to make the lift easier.
- Always be aware of power cords etc. When manoeuvring the lifter under the bed.

1. Place sling behind user so that padded underarm sections are just below the axilla.

2. To fit the security belt fasten the Velcro first.



3. Then close the buckle at navel level. Ensure the belt is snugly and securely fitted.



4. Feed each leg strap underneath each leg, ensuring no twists or folds in the fabric.



5. Bring the straps through the yellow webbing loop to ensure user comfort and safety (optional).



6. Once sling is in place, connect the desired loops (or clips) to the yoke. If using loop attachments, ensure the colours are the same on each side.



1. Feed sling behind user's back down to base of spine and position centrally.



2. Pass the leg strap that features the black midline leg strap beneath both legs.



4. Feed the coloured loop straps through the small security loops at each side.



7. Commence your lift, ensuring that all loops (or clips) remain secure on the yoke at all times. If correctly positioned, all straps should take up at the same time.



8. When removing the sling, ALWAYS peel it away from the user to avoid skin friction/shear.









3. Then bring the plain leg strap beneath it, through the large security loop.



6. Once sling is in place, connect the desired loops to the yoke. If using loop attachments, ensure the colours are the same on each side.

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### **CARING FOR YOUR SLING**

#### E. Deluxe Padded Standing Sling (From Sitting)

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1. Place sling behind user so that padded underarm sections are just below the axilla.



2. To fit the security belt fasten the Velcro first.



3. Then close the buckle at navel level. Ensure the belt is snugly and securely fitted.



4. Move your lifter into place so that the user's feet are on the foot plate. Attach the desired loops (or clips) to the yoke.



5. Once sling is in place, connect the desired loops (or clips) to the yoke.



6. As the lifter raises, the user should hold the lifter grab handles, look forward and gently lean into the sling.

To ensure the longevity and safety of your sling, it is important to care for it appropriately.
